A brief overview of the Halloween Fireworks was provided by the Rec Coordinator after discussions with the Fire Chief as the Fire Department and Fire Association will be running the BBQ and Fireworks. The Rec Committee agreed to purchase candy and provide candy bags for the evening.

5. BREAKFAST WITH SANTA PLANNING

The Rec Coordinator provided an overview of the planning details that were required for last year's event. Multiple ideas were discussed including SIMPCW participating with the craft table and the library spearheading another activity.

It was then suggested a full day of Christmas Events take place on the same Sunday as Breakfast with Santa and the Christmas Tree Light-Up including an open street hockey play at the Seniors Centre parking lot with a craft fair inside and possibly getting IDA to hold their Christmas Shopping evening as well. Thoughts regarding contacting the Kamloops Blazers were discussed to offer a player or hockey equipment for the day.

It was determined a separate working party will be scheduled to iron these items out.

6. 2024 BUDGET

It was determined that the 2024 Budget will be moved to a future Committee Agenda with the full breakdown of last year's spending to budget for the upcoming year properly.

7. JAYS CARE FOUNDATION APPLICATION

An overview of the application was provided, and the consensus was determined that an application be put through for Girls at Bat. Kevin Kershaw was mentioned as a possibility for the coach and a further meeting will be arranged if the application is approved.

8. PUBLIC INQUIRIES

Harry Waldron provided the Committee with his background as Director of Trails BC and his volunteer work with both provincial and national trails. He is interested in the connectiveness of the current trails in Barriere and wondering how he is able to volunteer and assist with a long-term plan.

Chair Lodge explained looking for funding is always important and explained some of the current trails that require work/the status of each. It was agreed upon by both parties that more volunteer energy towards the community plan will help with funding in the long term.

It was suggested that a Sub-Committee be created for trails as part of the Recreation Committee. The Rec Coordinator will inquire about this and report back at a future meeting. John Pederson, also in attendance, volunteered on assisting with this sub-committee if created.
