The Recreation Committee confirmed a date to hold the Volunteer Fair for May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023, and an approximate time for 2:00pm – 6:30pm.

The Recreation Coordinator provided a table of District sanctioned events with the approximate cost associated in past years as well as where the funding comes from. Discussion ensued that as this is the first year of the Recreation Committee and one new event is already in the works, a larger budget would be required to assist with new events and recreation programming as well as to provide the Recreation Committee with the opportunity to possibly improve current events.
