Multiple ideas including hockey rinks, basketball courts, disc golf, beach volleyball were discussed but it was decided these are not as inclusive to the entire community as multiple seniors were involved with the Challenge. It was agreed upon that a sound system, screen, and projector for the Bandshell would be inclusive to the entire community.

It was noted that \$15,000 does not go very far in some cases and it was suggested that the Recreation Committee ask both DoB Council, and Simpow FN Council to match the funds won. With the possibility of this additional funding, it was agreed that a full sound system

including a soundboard for larger bands, a screen and projector and built-in speakers could likely be purchased. If any funds remain, ideas of permanent games placed around the park were verbalized.
