## Temporary Borrowing Bylaw District of Barriere

Bylaw No. 235

Being a bylaw to authorize temporary borrowing pending the sale of debentures.

WHEREAS it is provided by S. 181 of the *Community Charter* that the Council may, where it has adopted a loan authorization bylaw, without further assents or approvals, borrow temporarily under the conditions therein set out;

AND WHEREAS the Council has adopted Bylaw # 234, cited as *Water & Wastewater Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 234,* authorizing borrowing for the purpose of performing improvements to District of Barriere water & wastewater systems, in the amount of one million, nine hundred and five thousand dollars (\$1,905,000);

AND WHEREAS the sale of debentures has been temporarily deferred;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Barriere, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Council is hereby authorized and empowered to borrow an amount or amounts not exceeding the sum of one million, nine hundred and five thousand dollars (\$1,905,000), as the same may be required.
- 2. The form of obligation to be given as acknowledgement of the liability shall be a promissory note or notes bearing the corporate seal and signed by the Mayor and the Financial Administration Officer.
- 3. The money so borrowed shall be used solely for the purposes set out in *Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 234*.
- 4. The proceeds from the sale of the debentures or so much thereof as may be necessary shall be used to repay the money so borrowed.
- 5. This bylaw may be cited as "Temporary Borrowing Bylaw No. 235".
