CAO UPDATE:

Community Relations:

- Met with Fort Modular to discuss possible affordable housing locations in town.

Voyageur Country Wilderness Estates at Dixon Creek Rd Development DL 57 & DL 570, bulk water study is completed with copy sent to Mr. Delaney.

Utilities:

The new well can be connected to the system, commissioned and put into service with the PLC processor, now secured. DW 3 will undergo the commissioning process and once DW3 is commissioned and ready for service then the DW2 pump can be pulled and check valve / pump replaced. A new pump has been ordered for DW 2, the current replacement pump is undersized and will be shipped back to the supplier.

CORPORATE OFFICER:

- Today, (February 14, 2022) marks the first live-stream of the District of Barriere Council and Committee Meetings. Limitless AV completed the install and staff training last week. The system seems very user friendly and hopefully will enable all those wishing to watch/attend meetings virtually a convenient way to do so. This now industry standard system not only allows for staff to be able to be responsive when working from home or out in the field without having to share personal cell phone information, but also will save the District over \$3,030 per year in phone bill charges. This change will not result in any down time or interruption of District services. All emergency analog and security lines will remain unchanged as a hardwired Telus lines.
