## 3. 2022 DRAFT BUDGET DISCUSSION – 2<sup>nd</sup> review

The Finance Officer continued from the last meeting's review of the proposed 2022 budgets. Key items noted were as follows:

i) Wastewater Facilities

Camera Inspection - \$50k FCM funding (with our portion of 20% - (offset our commitment to that grant) to inspect all the sewer lines and clear/ clean out where needed.

## ii) Water

- Chlorine Pump & Analyzer for \$11,100.00
- License Fees \$18,500

# iii) General Operations

- Gym Rental:
  - Gaining full control from SD73 over the gym will cost \$31,000 /yr. Staff will approach YCS to discuss any potential desire to cost share at 33% of that amount.
- Bumped up expected contract revenue with PROV Fire Service as directed by Council at the last meeting.
- Salaries/Admin part of that increase is due to a transfer of budget from Parks/Roads to create the new "Public Works Manager" position.
- Added \$2,500 to the Economic Development line item as requested at the last budget meeting.

# iv) Capital Projects

Asset Management Status was questioned and it was answered that TRUE Engineering will be assessing Barriere's roads and other large assets in the spring and then will be incorporating a list and plan at that point.

Leonie Creek Dam – Previous direction from Council was to look into the feasibility of decommissioning the Dam. Staff have been working with an inspector and the options available going forward. A report will be forthcoming to Council.
