## Covid-19 Relief Grant Application - Organizations

Barriere Minor Ball is a non-profit youth sporting organization. We have annual revenue that ranges from \$5000 to \$7000 which matches our expenses within a few hundred dollars every year.

Our revenue is primarily from registration fees – approximately 66% - sponsorships from local businesses make up the rest of our income. Our primary source of sponsorship funding is from signs that we hang on the outfield fence at the main 1 ball diamond. Each sign sponsor pays \$200/year.

In 2020, Covid-19 caused the cancellation of our season. The result was zero registration income and zero sponsorship income. To protect the signs, they were removed. In 2021, we were able to have a partial season, however, the uncertainty and the significantly delayed start of the season resulted in our registration numbers dropping over 50% and a second year of zero sponsorship income. In 2022, are numbers improved over 2021 but are still significantly less than our pre-Covid registrations. The overall impact of Covid-19 on our local economy continues to affect our sponsorship revenue. We have been unable to reinstate our sign sponsorship program.

We will use the grant funding to ensure that Barriere Minor Ball is able to operate in the 2023 season. Funds will be used to pay for insurance, Softball BC fees, upgrade equipment/uniforms, field maintenance, and potentially clinics for coaches, players, and umpires to help us recruit and retain the volunteers that we need to operate our organization.
