| <b>Re: Proposed Seal Coating: Yard Road Westside Shoulder</b> |  |

**Background:**

Yard Road Upgrades -

Upgraded the 254-m long section of pavement between Station Road and the Petro Canada (see *photo below*), which consisted of pulverizing the existing asphalt surface, grading the existing base, and placing a 75-mm thick x 9-m wide hot mix asphalt layer. In addition to the paving yard road the west shoulder was upgraded with a gravel and recycled asphalt mix.

**Discussion:** Now that the road repairs are completed on Yard Road, it is recommended that the shoulder on the west side receive a seal coating of reclaimite recycling agent. This will harden up the surface and extend the life of the shoulder as it is overused by heavier vehicles for parking during and throughout the day and night.

**Recommendation:** That Council approve the seal coating of the shoulder on the west side of Yard Road at the quoted price of \$7,207.20 to come from the General Surplus account for 2022.
